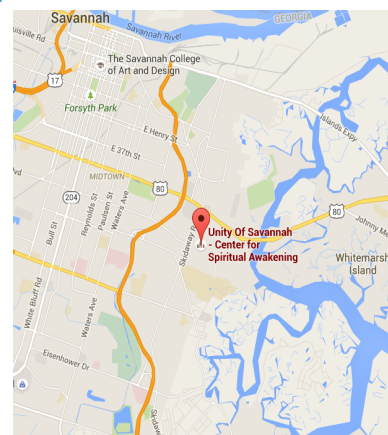


UNITY OF SAVANNAH, GA

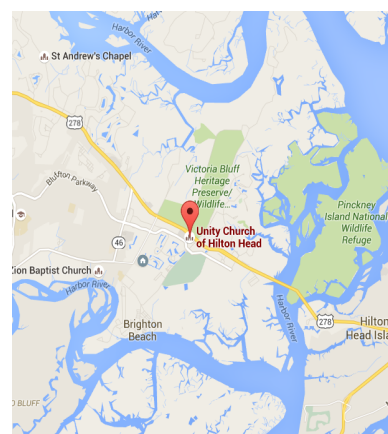
UNITY OF HILTON HEAD, SC

UNITY OF MT. PLEASANT, SC

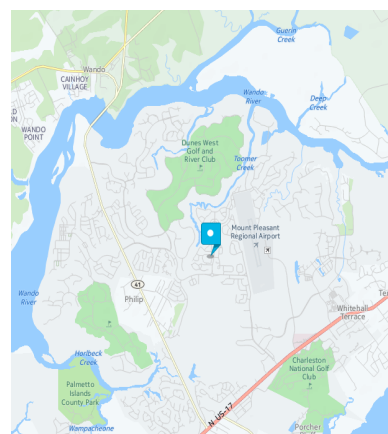
Kimberly Renollet Heck is the Spiritual Leader of Unity of Mt. Pleasant and is on a ministerial path through Unity Urban Ministerial School.

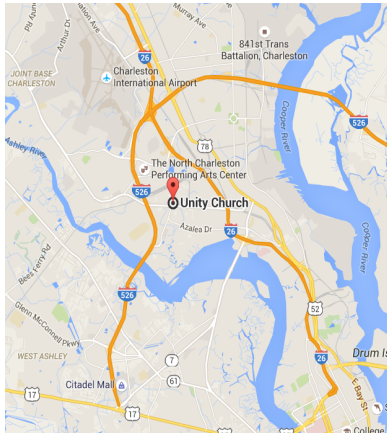

UNITY OF CHARLESTON, SC

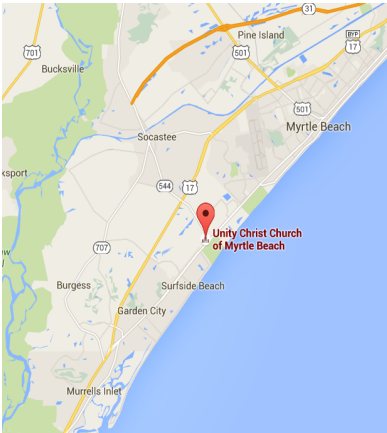

REV. RENÉ & MARIE PARE

Unity of Wilmington is a spiritual community built on the foundation of love by Rev. René Pare and his beautiful wife Marie Pare. Their love of God and willingness to say yes to the call of ministry continues to touch lives today after 40 plus years. René recently shared with me some of his ministry highlights that include his being admitted to ministerial school at Unity Institute, being ordained, and watching his spiritual communities grow.

The call to ministry began over forty years ago when René and Marie met their first Unity minister Rev. Jack Boland in Detroit Michigan and were quickly drawn to new ways of living through Unity Principle. During their initial encounter Rev. Jack handed them a card with the telephone number of a prayer ministry called the Dial –A –Thought. Their call to that number eventually led them to a workshop entitled Positive Uses of the Mind. Application of the tools learned in that workshop transformed their lives in a matter of weeks. They begin to give their tithes from a consciousness of joy living by the directive given in 2 Corinthians 9:7 “God loves a cheerful giver” and immediately experienced a turn around in their financial circumstances. René once shared that he would not write a check to pay a bill unless he could do so from a place of joy. If he did not feel joy he would ask Marie to write the check to pay the bill. What a beautiful example of living Principle!

René and Marie moved to Wilmington NC and started a study group that would eventually become Unity of Wilmington. One summer, René travelled to Unity Village to take classes for two weeks. It was during this time he decided to answer his call to

ministry, returned to Wilmington, sold their house, and moved his family to Lee’s Summit to begin ministerial school.

René and Marie returned to Wilmington in 1985 after successfully serving ministries in San Diego, California and Orlando, Florida. The decision to return was influenced by a single question posed by Rev. Edwene Gaines: “If you are not where you want to be, doing what you want to do, why not?” Their answer led René and Marie back to Wilmington where the study group hired its first minister, René Pare, and began the process of becoming Unity of Wilmington. By 1989 the community had outgrown its physical space and needed to expand. René and Marie practiced Principle, as Charles Fillmore had done years before, and began a building fund with their contribution of two cents. Soon others were participating in the expansion by buying wall studs for \$1.50 each and placing their name on them. Bricks were purchased with individual’s names and laid in front of the new building. People began to show up to assist as the movement of Spirit brought forth plumbers, painters, roofers and interested helpers at just the right time. Today we continue to feel the energy of love that infused each stud, brick and heart that contributed to expanding the presence of Unity in Wilmington.

After many exciting years of service to Unity of Wilmington René and Marie retired from ministry. But, does a minister ever retire? René answered this question with one of his own: “Do you ever retire as a person?” I know that I am one of many people who have been blessed by knowing René and Marie Pare, and since there is no private good, we have all been blessed.

“René once shared that he would not write a check to pay a bill unless he could do so from a place of joy. If he did not feel joy he would ask Marie to write the check to pay the bill. What a beautiful example of living Principle!

Step 1 Awakening the Soul

We have been like spiritual Rip Van Winkles who have been asleep for many years. The spiritual side of ourselves has been ignored. Your soul is part of your true and natural self and has the answers to all of life's most perplexing questions. Your soul is the container of the joy and fulfillment you long for. Awakening that part of you is the beginning of real wisdom and knowledge. The soul knows the deepest truths of your being. It can show you what your purpose is and how to fulfill it. The awakening of your soul will fill the nagging hole of emptiness that everyone feels. Once awakened, you will begin to discover the steps to a dance that you were made for, a dance you were invited to long ago and is still going on. It's the soul's dance of joy and purpose. Dancing denotes joy and joy comes from the soul. The purpose of the soul is to follow the joy, which leads to greater experiences of joy! Sirens, loud voices, shaking and crisis (drama)

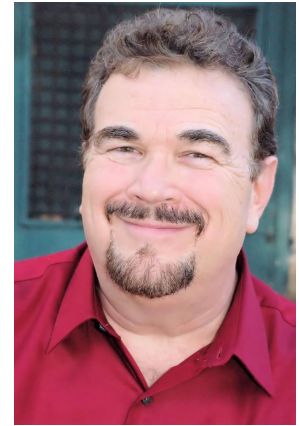
Gentleness, soft voices, caresses and quiet (love)

The problem with this scenario is that the only time a connection is made with the soul is when there is a crisis. A crisis-oriented person soon forgets the soul and needs another trauma in order to feel their loving connection with the soul again. Of course the very reason for the constant drama is the disconnected spiritual life.

The other choice is to invite the soul in to your quiet moments of inner communion and connect in a quiet and gentle way. This allows for a healing of the disjointed feelings of separation, confusion, and loneliness. Instead of an ambulance service your soul becomes your teacher and guide. Be gentle and allow yourself to feel the stirring of this wise friend and companion. We have many lessons to learn and each revelation will bring more freedom into your life.

What is the next step?

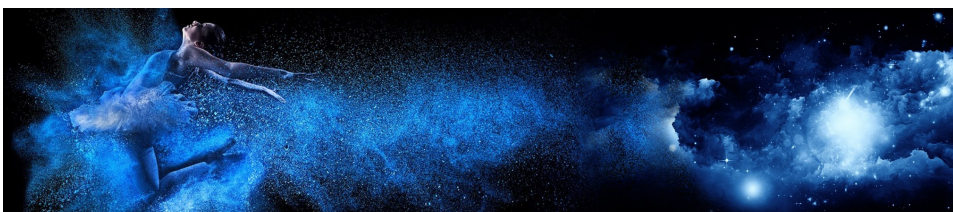

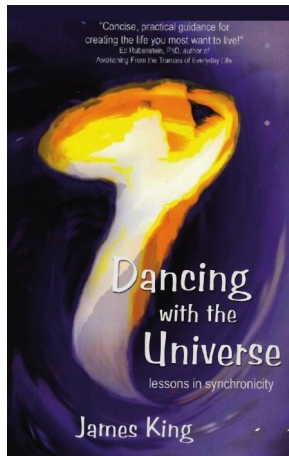
Editors Note:

Step 2

Oneness

All are one. This is the basis of all truth. All people are connected to each other. We are family. We are all related to every being in the universe. The only separation that exists is that which we create in our minds. Outwardly we appear to be separate but we are held together by the one Spirit that we all are. This is a truth that must be understood before anything else can make sense. A sign that your soul is awakening causes you to notice the sense of oneness with all that is. Being aware of this oneness changes your view of the world and the universe. No longer is everything “out there.” The world and the universe become inner landscapes into which your soul can journey.

The Intimate Universe

Oneness means that I have an intimate relationship with the universe. In a very real sense I am the universe and the universe is me. We are so closely joined that it is nearly impossible to tell where one begins and the other ends. The universe is my partner and is willing to share with me all of the wonderful secrets that my soul is ready for. Anything less than universal principles cannot fill the soul’s vast desire for growth and expansion. Thoughts of strife and division are not the kind of nourishment your soul needs. Anything that contracts or takes away from something else is a divider and is moving further away from your soul. Through intimacy I can gain the experience of integration and healing of all the parts of myself. I can be whole. This is the dance of the soul with the universe as they move together. RECOLLECTIONS OF THE SUMMER SOLSTICE

Summer Solstice is so named because the sun appears stationary in its northern and southern progression. In the Northern hemisphere, the sun is directly over the tropic of Cancer at the summer solstice and we have the longest day and shortest night.

Midsummer Eve is one of the nights of the year when boundaries between the worlds are thin and porous. In this warm season farmers' animals and crops may be more subject to disease, and the fields need prolonged sun with enough rain to ensure a successful crop. Midsummer festival, even in Christian times, focuses on the sun/fire and water. This festival was most important in the northern lands where the sun is weakest and the growing season the shortest.

To the Celts, Anu or Danu is Mother Earth, Goddess of fertility, prosperity, and comfort; the Mother of the Gods, Great Mother, Moon Goddess and it is She who blesses the animals and plants by the affirmations of the faith-filled so that food is available throughout the year.

Saxon tradition places Litha opposite of Yule. At midsummer, the Sun God reaches greatest strength and is portrayed on his greenwood throne as lord of the forests. You can find his face in church architecture gazing from leafy masks. The Christian religion converted this day of Jack-in-the-Green to the Feast of St. John the Baptist, portraying him in rustic attire and sometimes with horns. As Christianity became more dominant, Midsummer's Eve became Saint John's Eve.

Midsummer is celebrated with bonfires and the thought that fire could stave off evil spirits. In some cultures, Sunwheels, balls of hay and straw, are lit on fire and rolled down a hill into the ocean, lakes and rivers. Music festivals and cookouts are common celebrations and traditionally, the unpledged collect flowers and charms to place on their bed in order to dream of

their future partner.

A rural English tradition was to build a big bonfire on Midsummer's Eve, called "setting the watch," as fire would keep evil spirits out of the town. Some holders would light a fire on their land, while others would carry torches from one bonfire to another. Irish tradition is to carry a small stone in your hand and whisper affirmations to it while circling the bonfire, then throw the stone into it to manifest them.

Often, couples handfasted the year before at Beltane, bonded in a more formal handfasting at Midsummer or Lughnasadh (August 1st). Questions to oracles on matters of love are especially productive on Midsummer's eve. The midsummer moon is called the Honey Moon, the hives are filled with honey that may be fermented into mead, which was frequently available at wedding parties. We see the roots of current marriage traditions growing from early pagan practices.

Midsummer was an important solar event in the evolution of human culture. The axis of Stonehenge, aligned with the monument's entrance, is oriented in the direction of the midsummer sunrise. The Teotihuacan Temple of the Sun, a pre-Columbian temple in Mexico, is also oriented to the sun's path at the Summer Solstice. For the ancient Egyptians, Sirius (the dog star) rose on the Summer Solstice bringing the beginning of their new year, just before the season of the Nile's flooding.

At this season the fullness of life, in its most magnificent abundance, is appreciated. We affirm in celebration that The Source continues to bless us in each turn of the Earth. Love and commitment are developed within us.

Shakespeare, the Bard provides entertaining reading for Midsummer in A Midsummer Night's Dream, Macbeth, and The Tempest.
